
In this lull, remember: this is the time of year when the ideas are hatched, the plans get sharpened, and the next season starts taking shape behind the scenes.



As February approaches, we are inching our way towards the dock auction. February 22, 2026, is the date, make sure it's on your calendars. Below is a list of available docks, including one jet ski dock.

C-02-B	40'	14'	Deep Draft
C-03-B	40'	14'	Deep Draft
C-21-B	40'	14'	Road
C-26-B	40'	13.1'	Spit
J-04	12'	6'	South Lagoon
O-11-A	30'	11'	South Lagoon
S-09-A	40'	13.4'	Beach
S-20-A	35'	13.2'	Spit
S-22-B	41'	16'	Spit

There are a couple key things to consider for the dock auction. Only B and D members in good standing with the club can bid on docks. If you will be using a proxy, the proxy must also be a B or D member in good standing with the club. Permission for proxy must be in writing (email, text message, written letter) and provided to the fleet captain prior to the start of the dock auction. If anyone has any questions regarding the dock auction, rules associated with it, and dock award please contact me directly. Looking forward to the big day.
